1. Objectives

- To strengthen students' awareness of the importance of neat and legible handwriting;
- To enhance students' calligraphy skills;
- To provide students with opportunities to understand the core values of Catholic education, and the philosophy of education of Tack Ching Girls' Secondary School.

2. Categories

Junior Primary: A. Primary 3

Senior Primary: C. Primary 5

D. Primary 6

3. Competition Rules

- Each contestant submits ONE piece of work, and the work cannot be modified after submission.
- All entries must be originally written by the contestant.
- Junior Primary: Printing letters; use only pencils, marks remaining from erasers may lead to mark deduction.
- Senior Primary: Cursive writing; use only blue/black ball pen. Correction fluid and correction tape are not allowed to use. Otherwise, the contestant will be disqualified from the competition.
- Writing format: Write straight from left to right.
- Maximum entries from each school: Junior Primary: 30 entries; Senior Primary: 40 entries.

5. Scoring Criteria

Entries will be evaluated based on the following five criteria:

| Layout, Spacing and Consistency (choice of layout and margins; spacing | 30% |

| Neatness (clean presentation and proper alignment on the paper) | 10% |

- All submitted entries will not be returned.

8. Announcement of Results

- The results will be announced on the school website on 28st November, 2025 3rd December, 2025. Awardees will be notified individually.
- The prize-giving ceremony will be held on 14th December, 2025 at Tack Ching Girls' Secondary School.
- All awardees must attend the prize-giving ceremony. No prizes will be presented after the ceremony.
